 4. Who forges Achilles' armor? *Apollo - Euphorbus*
 5. For how many chapters does Achilles' aristeia last? *Hephaestus - told by Thetis*
 6. Athena takes the form of this man to trick Hector into fighting Achilles.
 7. Who guides Priam to Achilles' tent? *Deiphobus*
 8. Priam calls Achilles to remember whom? *Hermes*
 9. Who wears Achilles' armor after Patroclus' death? *Peleus - father*
